From the Head of School

Since 2012, the School has invited students to complete a survey every two years. Students are able to rate the performance of the School and provide feedback on areas where you would like to see improvements. The surveys are an important way for the School to understand what we do well and where we could improve.

This will be the fifth survey that students have participated in, and we now have excellent data that helps us to understand how students view some of the key areas within the School. I was pleased to see that the satisfaction score for the School from the students was 79% - which was the same as in 2018.

The following pages highlight the results from the survey questions, including graphs and tables that show the areas that had the highest satisfaction (co-curricular) to those that had the lowest (homework).

We also provide a summary of the comments that students provided when asked to about areas they least valued, those that could be improved and those students value the most.

Parents and staff also provided their feedback in a similar survey and it was wonderful to see that all of our community valued many of the same things, such as the camp program and the variety of co-curricular offered.

I would like to thank you for your time and honesty as your feedback will contribute to us continuing to improve this wonderful School.



Student Survey Results 2020

The School employs an external company to conduct the survey on our behalf. The survey questions target key performance areas of the School with answers compiled to give the School an overall satisfaction score. The graph and table below provide the satisfaction score for each key area.

The School continues to score well in all key performance areas.

The areas highlighted in green are those that have scored between 4 and 5. This represents an excellent level of satisfaction of this area.

The areas in blue have scored between 3 and 4. This represents a good level of satisfaction in this area.

There were no areas that were noted as requiring immediate action or concern.

Student General Comments

Students were able to provide comments in a general section at the end of the survey. Students could comment on things that were least valued, provide input on areas that could be improved and on things that you value the most.

Many (23%) of you noted that there was nothing that you did not value at the School, with several students commenting that while they personally did not value a program, they recognised that other students did. Sport was an area that students felt could be improved. The majority of students who commented valued the Camp program most of all; sport, including Country Week and the many opportunities available to students were also highly valued.

It was pleasing to note that nearly 80% of students who responded were proud to be a student at our School and nearly 85% of respondents indicated that you enjoyed taking part in co-curricular activities, with 82% noting they are involved in activities that take place outside the classroom.

Learning beyond the classroom

One of the things we aim to do at our School is to provide all of our students with the opportunity to be best you can be. We do this by providing students with access to a wide variety of opportunities, so that you have a well-rounded education. Our staff work hard, to teach you important lessons in the classroom and to provide you with valuable lessons outside of the classroom.

Our Camp program is integral to allowing all our students to grow and learn more about themselves and what they can achieve. Parents and staff were also able to provide comment, and, like the students, they valued the camp and other programs that provide opportunities to learn beyond the classroom.

It was wonderful to see that 84% of students indicated that doing their best was important to them. I encourage all of our students to continue to strive to do your best each day.
