at Bunbury Cathedral Grammar School



Bunbury Cathedral Grammar School invites all members of our School Community to be a part of our ***Glimpses of Grammar***, a community project to celebrate the School's 50 Year Anniversary.

This community project invites individuals to create their own work that captures a glimpse of their time at Bunbury Cathedral Grammar School. Each work is to be 9 inches by 5 inches – (23cm by 13cm) in size, either landscape or portrait. Our ***Glimpses of Grammar*** will then be displayed together as a celebration of our community at the Art and Technology Exhibition held in November this year.

***Glimpses of Grammar***, is inspired by the [9 by 5 Impression Exhibition](#), which was hosted by a group of Australian Painters in Melbourne in 1889. The majority of the works were on 9 by 5 inch cedar cigar box lids, which were the artists impressions that focused on the reality of daily life.

What will your ***Glimpse of Grammar*** be?

It is open to your interpretation and could include images of friends, students, teachers, family, nature, buildings, sport, poetry, animals, activities, events – your glimpse of the School. It could be a moment that you shared or experienced, a glimpse from this year or perhaps one from 50 years ago.

The works could be paintings, drawings, photos, tapestry, woodwork, metal work, collage, textiles, mosaic, digital images, lino print, etc. The work will be hung on a wall, so please take this into consideration when creating your work.

So let your creative ideas start to flow and embark on your ***Glimpse of Grammar!***

Submitting your ***Glimpse of Grammar***

You are welcome to post or hand deliver your ***Glimpse of Grammar*** to the School. Entries can be:

***Glimpses of Grammar*** Guidelines:

1. Work must be submitted with a completed Glimpses of Grammar Entry Form.
2. Work must be 23cm by 13cm (portrait or landscape). This includes the frame if adding one.
3. Work should not contain any sharp, dangerous, heavy or unsuitable materials which may be a hazard or that may damage other artworks.
4. Work must be stable and of sound construction to avoid damage during handling.
5. Work must be able to be hung on a wall.
6. Work must be appropriate to be exhibited at the Art and Technology Exhibition in November 2022. Work may challenge established views; however, it is important to consider and take into account the values of the audience and wider community. Any work that is unsuitable to be exhibited by the School will not be used.
7. Work will remain the property of Bunbury Cathedral Grammar School unless the Entry Form states otherwise.
8. Work must be your own and is not plagiarised.
9. Bunbury Cathedral Grammar School may choose to use images of submissions for promotional purposes.
