



# Grammar Netball Season 2023

## Hawks Netball Club

The Bunbury Cathedral Grammar School Netball Club will enter teams into the Bunbury Netball Association and the Leschenault Netball Association. We are also exploring the opportunity of entering teams into the Busselton Netball competition however, this will depend on player interest. Please see information below regarding the 2023 netball season.

### **BUNBURY NETBALL ASSOCIATION**

The Bunbury Netball Association runs a Saturday competition for all divisions. The Friday night competition is now scheduled for Representative teams only.

#### **Saturday – Net Set Go**

- SET TIER (Skills and games) - Must be turning 7-8 in 2023 (born in 2015-16)
- GO TIER (Games) - Must be turning 9-10 in 2023 (born in 2013-14)
- Both are played OUTDOORS at the BNA Courts
- The season will commence on **Saturday, 13 May 2023 (Term 2)**
- The season will finish on **Saturday, 19 August 2023 (Term 3)**

#### **Saturday – All Divisions**

- Open to students born in 2012 and older (must be 11 by 31/12/23)
- It is played OUTDOORS at the BNA Courts
- The season will commence with grading on **Saturday, 29 April and Tuesday, 2 May 2023 (Term 2)**
- The last round for the season will be on **Saturday, 19 August 2023 (Term 3)**
- There will be FOUR Tuesday night matches – **16 May, 13 June, 18 July, and 8 August**
- Finals will commence on **Saturday, 26 August 2023** and finish on **Saturday 9, September 2023 (Term 3)**

### **LESCHENAULT NETBALL ASSOCIATION**

#### **Thursday/Friday – All Divisions**

- Open to students in Year 7 to 12
- It is played INDOORS at the Leschenault Leisure Centre
- Matches are played mainly on Friday night, but some lower divisions may play on Thursday night
- The season commences with grading on **Friday, 28 April (Term 2)**
- The last round for the season will be on **Thursday, 17 August / Friday, 18 August (Term 3)**
- Finals will commence on **Friday, 25 August** and finish on **Friday, 1 September (Term 3)**

### **BUSSELTON NETBALL ASSOCIATION**

#### **Saturday – Junior**

- Open to students born in 2011 and older, up to those born in 2007
- It is played OUTDOORS at the Lois Hannay Courts
- The season will commence with grading on **Saturday, 29 April 2023 (Term 2)**



- Finals will commence on **Saturday, 26 August 2023** and finish on **Saturday 9, September 2023 (Term 3)**

## Monday – Senior

- Open to students born in 2005 & 2006 (18/20&U)
- It is played INDOORS at the Geographe Leisure Centre
- The season will commence with grading on **Monday, 1 May 2023 (Term 2)**
- Finals will commence on **Saturday, 28 August 2023** and finish on **Saturday 9, September 2023 (Term 3)**

## FEES

We are again able to build the admission fee charged by the Bunbury, Leschenault, and Busselton Netball Associations for each game into our fees. Hence, the fees include all payments expected for the season, including insurance and admission fees for the students each week.
