Bookings and Cancellations

All children must be booked to attend the relevant session by completing the online form and making payment prior to attendance. Cancellations must be made in writing 48 hours in advance for a refund to be considered. Non-attendance on a booked day will incur the full day charge.

Unwell children should not attend the centre.



Child Care Subsidy
