

2024 Year 10 School Based Immunisations

Dear Parent/Guardian,

The School Based Immunisation Team will be visiting your child's school this term to provide the Yr10 students with their scheduled one dose of **Meningococcal ACWY vaccine**. This vaccine protects against 4 strains of meningococcal disease.

All students require parent/guardian consent before they can receive any vaccinations at school.

The SBIP Team will be visiting Bunbury Cathedral Grammar School on Tuesday 30th April 2024.

Parents/guardians are requested to either Consent to vaccination for their child or Decline (if you choose **not** to have your child immunised) via:

1. VaccinateWA (preferred). Please use the student's current account or add them as a dependant under a parents' account.

OR

2. Complete the secure online Form- via Healthy WA SBIP or *QR code below*. (Information provided will be uploaded into the VaccinateWA system).

3. Paper based Immunisation Consent Form (collect from School) This must be *completed, signed, and returned to the school*. (Information provided will be uploaded into the VaccinateWA system).

All vaccines provided will be recorded in the Australian Immunisation Register (AIR).

Students who miss a dose at school can still receive vaccinations at: Community Immunisation Clinics, GP's, Aboriginal Medical Services or participating Pharmacies (consultation fees may apply).
