Dear Parents

This is an introductory letter about the Year 4 Camp, which is to be held at Lions Dryandra Woodlands Village, north of Narrogin, from **24 June-27 June 2025**. Accommodation and many of the activities will be at the Village.

The bus will leave for camp at **9.00am on Tuesday, 24 June**, from **Palmer Oval**. **Please ensure your child is there at 8.40am** to allow time for loading luggage and checking last minute items. The bus will arrive back at **Palmer Oval, BCGS on Friday, 27 June, at 2.45pm**.

Children are to travel in casual clothes. **No School uniforms are required. Students will need morning tea and lunch for Tuesday**. All other meals will be provided.

**NO electronic equipment, mobile phones or iPads**. Cameras are allowed but are taken at the student's own risk. The School will take no responsibility for damage to cameras. **NO extra snacks and/or lollies**.

**Medicine:** Students requiring medication need to provide the medication in its original packaging showing the name of the medicine, student's name and dosage required and also complete the attached Camp Administration of Medicine form. **IMPORTANT** - No medication will be accepted unless it is in the original packaging and the form has been completed. Medication must be given to staff on arrival at School.

Mrs Gordon and Mr Whirlledge will be responsible for dispensing items at the appropriate time. The only exception to this is an asthma puffer and/or Epipen which children must carry on their person at all times. It may be appropriate for children in this instance to carry their puffer or pen in a pouch around their waist. We will be walking in the bush at times, and they will need it near them.
